BAG TOSS

SCORING

- The object of the game is to score 21 points
- A bean bag that goes through the hole in the target box counts as 3 POINTS
- A bean bag that lands on the target box counts as 1 POINT unless it is knocked off
- A bean bag that lands on the ground counts as 0 POINTS
- If a bag is pushed into the hole, it counts as 3 POINTS for the team that owns that bag
- Bags are always tossed underhanded
- If the score is 11 - 0, the slaughter rule applies, and the team with 11 POINTS wins

RULES OF PLAY

WHEN PLAYING DOUBLES:

Teams will consist of the red team and the beige team. One player from the red team and one player from the beige team will stand at either box, across from their partners. To start the game, flip a coin to see who will shoot first. If the red team wins the toss, they will throw their bean bags consecutively at the target box. When all of their bean bags are thrown, the person standing next to them, the beige team, will throw their bean bags. After all the bags have been thrown, total all points for each player. The difference between the two will determine the points scored for that team. Now, the players on the opposite from the ones who started the game will proceed into round 2, with the person from the team that scored last going first and continuing in that fashion until 21 points are reached.

SINGLES:


After determining which person will go first, you would proceed as you would if you were playing in teams.

FOULS:

The foul line is at the front of the box. Fouls are made when the throwing player passes the foul line with the bags still in their hand. All foul bags are counted as 0 and are removed if they land on the target box.

THE SET-UP

Place target boxes 25½ feet apart or 30 feet from center holes as shown below
